Interview with Donna and Donna, our Southern Arizona Senior Games Directors

Our interview this month is about the upcoming Southern Arizona Senior Games. We have Donna Davis and Donna Coon in the studio today and they're here to share information about the Games. Like professional athletes they seem to start preparations for the next season a few days after each one ends.

[PickleBlast]: Thanks for taking some time to talk to us today, Donna and Donna. We're less than a month away from the Southern Arizona Senior Games and we'd like to know how things are shaping up. Are we doing well with registrations? Which categories are full and which still have availability?

[Donna Davis]: We currently have 360 people registered. For the 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5, 5.0 tournament we have almost 100 teams for the mixed doubles event and have closed that category for now. We have a few openings in men's doubles and we have room to add several women's teams. In the 2.0/2.5 round-robin event held on March 10 and 11, we are seeking more teams in all categories. The event will be held at the East Center courts. This is a great opportunity for people to "get their feet wet" in a tournament setting without the pressure of the double-elimination format. Registration for all events closes Feb. 20.

[Donna Coon]: For the 2.0/2.5 players, consider trying out the Round Robin competition. If you don't have a partner you can go ahead and sign up and you will be listed in 'Players Needing Partners'. Click Here to register.

[PB]: Is there anything new at this year's Games?

[DD]: We have two major fundraising events coming up. On March 6, 7, 8, 10, and 11 our club will be hosting the Southern Arizona Senior Games Pickleball Tournament. April 22 is the date for our first annual Swinging Fore Green Valley Pickleball Club Golf Outing. At both of these activities, we will be raffling and auctioning off various gift baskets, larger merchandise items, and handmade products from those with expertise in woodworking, quilting, pottery, jewelry making, photography, etc. We rely heavily on the donation of auction and raffle items from club members, friends, and businesses. An email letter with details on how people can contribute was sent to each club member. If each of us can do a little we can reap huge rewards.

[DC]: We are trying a new set up at Quail Creek this year. The GVR Foundation has agreed to rent 2 large tents which we will set up in the parking lot. One will be used for the event and referee desks and the other will be home to our 'sales' area - t-shirts, raffles, silent auctions, snacks, etc. This will leave the ramada open for the players to use between their matches.

[PB]: As a participant what are the three most important things I need to know?

[DD]: 1. Be patient. There are a lot of players and many divisions, so as long as you keep winning there will be some wait time.

2. Make sure you drink plenty of water. Dehydration is one of the major problems experienced by players during the day.

3. This year baked goods will be available and will be sold until they are gone. Food will also available throughout the day but the caterers leave about 2:00 so it is a good idea to have a sandwich and/or snacks with you if you are playing in the afternoon.

[DC]: Arrive early! Depending on your start time you may have a long walk to the courts. Quail Creek will be running a shuttle so watch for it. And plan to NOT use I-19 to get to the courts due to construction delays in the Green Valley area.

[PB]: As we all know, the success of these events is largely determined by the number of volunteers we have and the coordination to get everyone working together. Where do we need volunteers and what are the qualifications and expectations for each group?

[DD]: Go to our <u>club website</u> and click on SignUp Genius to see what opportunities are available. No experience necessary for many of our jobs. We need people to sell raffle tickets and baked goods. We also need line judges and referees You will see some great pickleball and also have the chance to buy raffle tickets and bid on some awesome silent auction items. Please consider giving us a few hours of your time.

[DC]: We've had a really good volunteer sign up this year and I am confident we'll get lots of help with our new categories. We need more referees and we are offering a Referee Refresher Clinic (open for new referees also) on **SignUpGenius** on Feb 26th.. Remember, line judges have the best seat in the house! We only use line judges for the medal matches and we need 4 per match (one to watch each line). Round up your friends and signup together!

[PB]: Donna and Donna, thanks for taking a few minutes to talk to us today and thank you so much for all the work you are and have been doing behind the scenes to make this year's Southern Arizona Senior Games a success!

Netiquette

- Who's call is it? Out calls belong to the team on the side of the court where the ball lands. In recreational play, it's not considered good form to be on the opposite side of the court and question the call. So, let the responsible team make the call and accept that there will be inaccurate calls from time to time.
- You'll notice two ball tubes at the courts now. One is for the Onix Pure 2 balls, the other for the DuraFast balls. Please return the correct ball to the correct holder.

We currently have no nominations for club Secretary and no one available to take this important position. If you or anyone you know has an interest in this position, please let us know.
- Just can't stress enough how much we need everyone to show support for new
 courts. Those in opposition are loud and persistent and the GVR Board is listening.
 If we're to ever have new courts, we all need to make our voice heard. Show up
 for the meetings, use the available channels to express your support to the GVR
 Board and to those reading the local paper. Silence on our part is interpreted as
 ambivalence. Make sure your expression is factual and positive. That's a direct

contrast to what the GVR Board and public have been hearing and we can make a difference!
