# **Board Meeting Highlights**

- New lock on East Center storage closet has wireless connectivity and codes can be assigned via a remote application for members requesting the use of the ball machine.
- The next round of decisions by the GVR Board are coming up regarding the purchase and development of the site for new courts. Please plan to attend these critical Board and committee meetings to show support, and to write to the GVR Board if you are not in the area.
- The Board will research the possibility of moving to electronic and/or proxy voting for club board members and bylaw revisions in the next few months. Current bylaws specify that members must be present at the annual meeting to cast a vote.
- The club will move to the new Onyx Fuse balls, which are more durable than the Onyx Pure and DuraFast balls now in use. Current inventory will be used prior to purchasing the Onyx Fuse replacements. The Board will raise the issue of more frequent court cleaning with GVR staff to provide a safer environment and reduce ball replacement costs.

Next board meeting is scheduled for September 12 at 6:00 pm at the East Center Lounge.

#### Interview with Pam Goodrich

This month's interview is with our new club secretary, Pam Goodrich. Pam started her two-year term last month. Let's hear what she has to say.

[PickleBlast]: Thanks for taking some time to talk to us today Pam. For our members who may not know you, tell us about your background, how you came to Green Valley, and how you discovered the game of pickleball.

[Pam Goodrich]: I was born and raised in a small town in Eastern Washington (Waterville) - population 1,014! Attended college at the U. of Puget Sound in Tacoma where, in 1966, I graduated with a double major in Psychology and German (go figure). I worked in the field of Social Work and as an Executive Director for most of my career (hospitals and non-profit agencies). Ten years prior to retirement, I was certified as a Life Care Planner and moved into the for-profit world by working in our privately-owned business.

[PB]: As you ran to become our club secretary, you must have some ideas about how we can improve and expand on what our club offers. Would you describe some of your ideas on how we can make our club better?

[PG]: The main reason I decided to run for Secretary was to just add one more person to the list of those of you who do SO much to make our pickleball club run smoothly. As with most other organizations, it seems there are too few doing way too much. It's wonderful to see the same faces so often but it's way past time for more of us to step up. My goal is and will be to constantly 'talk up' our pickleball experience, share and promote our vision, and encourage others to get more involved.
