INTERVIEW WITH JIM CONROY - GVR CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER

[PickleBlast]: Hi Jim. Thanks for taking some time today to chat with us and give us some insight on the latest developments surrounding a new pickleball complex. Recently the GVR Board authorized GVR staff to begin exploration for potential sites for the complex. Why is this an important step?

[Jim Conroy]: Pickleball is an extremely popular activity in our GVR community. Due to a shortage in GVR Pickleball courts it has been very challenging to properly accommodate our membership who enjoy playing this great activity. Pickleball is the fastest growing sport in the country, particularly amongst seniors. The GVR Board's direction for our CEO Kent Blumenthal to explore potential sites for a pickleball complex is the first step in this process of pursuing a pickleball complex. During this exploration of potential sites, Mr. Blumenthal and GVR staff will work closely with the Pickleball sub-committee. The Pickleball sub-committee was established under the authority of the GVR Planning & Evaluation committee. The Pickleball sub-committee is made up of a very knowledgeable group of GVR Pickleball Club members, and is chaired by Kathy Palese. I think Kathy and her group will provide very valuable insights and recommendations as to what will best

constitute a good site for a pickleball complex. GVR staff will work very closely with the Pickleball sub-committee to achieve the best result for our overall GVR membership.

[PB]: Once GVR staff has a prioritized list of potential sites, what are the next steps?

[JC]: Once potential sites are identified they will need to go through an examination process by the P&E Criteria Committee.

[PB]: How can we as pickleball club members contribute to and encourage progress towards the new pickleball complex?

[JC]: I think like any project or program that GVR members have an interest in seeing developed, it is important to stay involved in the process. That would entail attending both P&E Committee meetings as well as GVR Board meetings. I also believe it is important for pickleball advocates to stay informed about other potential stakeholder initiatives which can add value to GVR membership. Pickleball players may find interest in supporting these activities, too.

[PB]: Sounds like we may still be overcrowded during the 2017-2018 season. The temporary courts were a big help this year. Will we be able to find additional court space for the high season next year?

[JC]: Yes, I have already talked to Pima County Parks & Recreation Department concerning the possibility of reserving the Continental Community Center Pickleball courts again for next season. I'd like to start that rental much earlier next year, possibly even in the Fall of 2017.

[PB]: Great interview, Jim. Thanks for all that you do for us as GVR members. We really appreciate your support for our club.

- One more round of thanks to all of our volunteer coaches helping with Pickleball Orientation and Assisted Play. Your contribution to the introduction of our sport and our club is invaluable for helping us to grow and creates a lasting impression of the quality of our club and our sport.
