

Tournament – Game Format

About the Game Format

The format is a Whist Round Robin.

- Sign up as an individual.
- Flights are determined by a player's club skill level.
- Pools of eight players are drawn at random. There is a minimum of 3 pools per skill level.
- A Whist Cyclic round robin algorithm is used, where each player partners with each other player once and against each other player twice.
- Everyone plays 7 games – Approximately 2 hours
- After each round, players' point differentials are recorded.
- Winners are determined by the number of games won. Ties are broken by the point differential totals.
- Prizes will be given to 1st, 2nd, 3rd place winners in each pool.

Mixed Doubles

- Sign up with a partner.
- Play eight teams in a group.
- Play seven rounds.
- Four courts per pool needed.

Scoring Method

- MLP Rally Scoring – If not familiar, watch MLP Rally Scoring on YouTube.
- For 2.0/2.5 will be assist by Volunteer, Court Score Keepers.
- Play to 21, win by 1
