# **Board Meeting Highlights**

### 2023 Budget

The 2023 budget was approved based upon input from various committees and projections for 2023. Club dues will remain at \$15/year. For details refer to the Board Meeting minutes.

# Reserve Fund Subcommittee

A reserve fund subcommittee will be formed to set the guidelines for the transfer of money in and out of the reserve fund. The subcommittee will also make recommendations for future court and club improvements to be approved by the Club Board. The chair of this subcommittee will be the Club Treasurer and will include 3-5 Club members, to be identified.

#### **Policy Manual Updates**

Updates to the Policy Manual regarding Skill Level Play - SLP (formerly known as Focus Play) is in effect October 1st through May 31st and Mixed Skill Level Play - MSLP will be in effect June 1st through September 30th. In addition, Gold/Silver queuing system references were removed.

#### Member Agreement

A Club Member Agreement was approved by the Board. All members will be required to agree to this Member Agreement:

The purpose of the GVR Pickleball Club is to provide a safe, fun, and enjoyable environment for its members. This implies sportsmanship, respect, and proper court etiquette towards fellow Club members, guests, and GVR personnel. The Club will respect the needs and goals of all players endeavoring to provide events and play to meet all player needs.

This agreement may be revised from time to time. Each member is responsible for knowing the contents of the Membership Agreement and agrees to abide by its content.

Code of Conduct

- I will comply with the GVR Pickleball Club Policies and By-Laws.
- I will comply with posted court signage and schedules.
- I will adhere to the USAPA pickleball rules.
- I will make fair line calls and respect calls made by others.
- I will not act or play in a way that maliciously threatens my safety or the safety of others.
- I will refrain from verbal outbursts which are profane, threatening or abusive.
- I will respect GVR Recreation property and perform no actions which may cause damage.
- I will comply with the GVR Recreation applicable rules & policies.
- I will do my best to present a positive image to the local community as a representative of the GVR Pickleball Club.

#### Networking with Members

I understand that when I join the GVR Pickleball club, personal information is entered in the Club Member Directory (Pickleball Plus) which is available on a members-only password-protected page for networking with other members. I will not download, republish or duplicate the information in the Member Directory — in whole or in part — for commercial or any other purposes. I understand that a primary means of communication between the Club and its members is via email and agree to receive emails from the Club. No information will be shared outside the Club, without your permission.

#### Photo and Video

While not a regular occurrence, I understand that from time to time photos and videos may be taken during on court play and social gatherings. Use of media images will be limited to instructional, marketing, and social media purposes. I understand that I may request in writing that my image is not to be used.

#### Club Facebook Page

The Club will pursue creating a facebook page. Details need to be finalized but will include policies & practices, and administration guidelines of the facebook page. Two administrators are currently being identified. Look for more details as plans become finalized.

#### New Member Orientation

A new member orientation is currently being developed to target new and prospective members. The orientation will cover every aspect of the Club including the website, Pickleball Plus, history of the club, play types, scheduling, classes, etc. Watch for details on when these orientations will begin.

#### Club Classes

The Club offers classes free of charge to active club members for those looking to learn and to improve their skills. While there is no charge for these they do require registration through Pickleball Plus (<u>gvpc.pickleball.plus</u>).

Developing Skills for 2.0 & 2.5 players. Players are encouraged to use Developing Skills as a stepping stone to improve their skills after taking a GVR 101 class. Also, players may use Developing Skills as an introduction to pickleball, then move into a GVR 101 class. After 4 sessions players will need to join the Club to continue to sign up. These sessions incorporate drills and game play with a coach observer. Coaches are authorized to advance players from 2.0 to 2.5.
