New Member Club Orientation

In support of the Pickleball 101 classes in October and November, 2 new member club orientations have been held. 58 new and prospective members have attended so far to learn about the Club, where to play, and member benefits. Working with Mike Gustin and Al Willette orientations will be planned after the 2nd week of classes beginning in January.

SLP+1 Pilot Results

In early November, 6 players from each skill level (2,5, 3.0, & 3.5) participated in the SLP+1 pilot. SLP+1 allows players to both play with and against mentors from the next higher skill level. They also received coaching from the mentors during their play. It was successful based upon the feedback from the participants and the mentors.

After this pilot, the Scheduling Committee and others met to discuss what was learned and reviewed the feedback received from the pilot. The following is an overview of SLP+1 in its next version.

Purpose of SLP+1: SLP+1 is an opportunity for players to be mentored by those in the next higher skill level. This play is targeted for those players who want to improve their skills and game strategy to either prepare them to test to their next higher skill level or who wants to improve within their skill level. SLP+1 play is not recommended for the player who is simply wanting to find out what it is like to play against players in a higher skill level or for a player who may have just moved to their skill level.

In order to provide SLP+1 play to the most players and identify those players who may benefit the most from this mentoring, here are the details on how to participate. Players must be available for all 3 weeks of each session.

A session of SLP+1.

1st Week: A qualifying shuffle event for both men and women, which will determine the players who are eligible to participate the next 2 weeks of SLP+1. Tentatively, 4-8 men & women will qualify for the 2nd & 3rd weeks.

2nd & 3rd Week: The players will play in different formats with and against the mentors. Mentors will be providing on court coaching and evaluation of a player's skills and game play.

3 Week Sessions are tentatively scheduled for January - April. Participants may be limited to every other session depending upon the demand.

We have delayed the next session of SLP+1 until January due to the holidays and availability of mentors. Look for an announcement on the next session in late December.
