GVR PICKLEBALL CLUB ELECTION OF BOARD MEMBERS

Club Bylaws state members of the GVR Pickleball Club who have paid their annual dues in full by March 1 of each year and who are in good standing as GVR members shall be eligible to vote for the election of Board Members. Accordingly, The GVR Pickleball Club Annual Meeting will be held on Thursday, March 17, 2021 at 3 p.m. at Desert Hills and at which time votes will be tallied and new Board Members will be selected and announced.

Available voting methods: Electronic OR Paper Ballots

Ballots will be made available on Tuesday, March 1, 2022 with paper option (ballot and envelopes) available at Canoa Ranch, East Center and Kent J. Blumenthal Pickleball Complex and the electronic option through Pickleball.Plus.

4. If you wish to **DELAY** or **NOT** vote, click on the Cancel button to bypass. You will be taken into your Pickleball.Plus account. This step will repeat each time you log into your account until the ballot closes on Wednesday, March 16, 2022 at 6 p.m MST.

Instructions - PAPER BALLOT:

Paper ballots, secrecy envelopes, and transmission envelopes are provided at all three pickleball locations - Canoa Ranch, East Center, and Kent J. Blumenthal Pickleball Complex.

To authenticate eligibility of the voter via paper ballot, voters are **REQUIRED** to: 1) place the completed paper ballot in a secrecy envelope; 2) place secrecy envelope into a transmission envelope which shall show the voter's printed name, signature and GVR member ID number.

Ballots lacking these requirements will not be counted.

Submit the paper ballot to the Election Committee by the U.S. Mail, PO Box 845, Green Valley AZ 85622, or by depositing the ballot in the designated Pickleball Club dropboxes (located at East Center and Kent J. Blumenthal Pickleball Complex). Paper ballots postmarked by or deposited into the club's dropbox will be accepted until 6 p.m. on Tuesday, March 14, 2022.

The Election Committee shall tabulate all votes cast by these methods, verifying that each ballot contains a valid GVR member ID number, using the current member list described in Bylaws Section E. If a ballot does not include the GVR member ID number of a current GVR Pickleball Club member, the ballot shall be deemed invalid. Any duplicate ballots received and identified by the GVR member ID number shall also be deemed invalid.
